### **Forester**

**Education Requirements:** Bachelor of Science Degree (or higher) in a Forestry Related Major from an Accredited University.

**Description of Position:** Independent Contractor Position with the Tennessee Forestry Association (TFA). The forester would work closely with Riparian Zone Buffer Projects in the Elk and Duck River Watershed Counties in Southern Middle Tennessee. The position would also administer the Tennessee Tree Farm Program . Goals to Recruit and Retain Tree Farms across Tennessee with a focus in the Elk/Duck River Watershed Counties. (Maury, Marshall, Bedford, Coffee, Giles, Lincoln, Moore and Franklin).

**Experience:** Must have 5+ years of forestry experience and specifically should have on-the ground experience, with knowledge of federal and state landowner assistance programs and the American Forest Foundation (AFF) Tree Farm Program.

**Responsibilities:** Work with Federal and State Agencies, NGO Representatives, others on the Elk/Duck River Watershed Steering Committee to promote forest management in the Elk/Duck River Watershed Counties.
