TOWHEE GOLF CLUB

Welcome to Towhee Club, Middle Tennessee's new favorite golf club. Located in Spring Hill, just a short drive south of Nashville, Towhee Club is an 18-hole golf course designed by Arnold Palmer.

The golf course is named after the Eastern Towhee bird. The Towhee is heard far more often than it is seen. The towhee can commonly be found in the undergrowth along the edges of farm fields and backyards of Middle Tennessee. While they are often solitary, the towhee's distinctive call is a constant reminder of their presence. If you are lucky enough to spot these elusive birds, their ruddy orange and black feathers can be strikingly beautiful.

Just like the bird, Towhee Club might not be the flashiest or most extravagant, but once you catch a glimpse of it, you will not soon forget it. And you'll want to heed its call to return again and again.
